COVID-19 Grading Note In response to the Covid-19 Pandemic, Brunswick High School implemented an approved Pass/Fail procedure for Quarter 4 of the 2019-20 school year. As there were an adequate number of assessments from Quarter 3, students earned numeric grades for that marking period, and those grades were factored in to the students' GPA. Credit was awarded for semester or full year classes based on successful completion of coursework and is reflected on student transcripts.

Class Rank GPA

Procedurally, Brunswick High School recognizes class rank for purposes of Valedictorian and Salutatorian based on **seven** semesters using a 100-point system and is **weighted**. Grade point average is **unweighted**.
