BARELY BREATHING by Rebecca Donovan

Sixteen-year-old Katniss Everdeen accidentally becomes a contender in the annual Hunger Games, a grave competition hosted by the Capitol where young boys and girls are pitted against one another in a televised fight to the death. (Catching Fire is book #2, Mockingjay is book #3).

LONE WOLF by Jodi Picoult

When his father and sister are injured in an accident that has rendered his father comatose, estranged son Edward decides to stop his father's life support so that his organs can be donated, a choice his sister urges him to reconsider.

MATCHED (Matched, #1) by Ally Conde

Cassia has always had complete trust in the Society to make decisions for her, but when she is being paired with her ideal mate, a second face flashes on the screen, and Cassia begins to doubt the Society's infallibility as she tries to decide which man she truly loves (Crossed is book #2 and Reached is book #3).

MILA 2.0 by Debra Driza
