On Wednesday, February 14th we will be having a Classroom Community Celebration. In place of a traditional Valentine's Day party our class will be doing a special project. We will use the day to celebrate our classroom community and class promise. This is a great time of year for the students to reflect on how they are helping each other in our classroom (Being Bucket Fillers & Using Kind Words) as well as the growth they are making in keeping the promise.

We have had almost six months of practice in giving compliments. Every afternoon our class gathers on the meeting rug for closing circle. I've taught the children how to name helpful things we've seen classmates do during the day. Compliment circles bring a sense of warmth and caring to a classroom community. As a student of mine once wrote, "Compliment circles make everyone feel good." Throughout the week we will be writing compliments to each other. The compliments will then be put into individual "Compliment" booklets.

We are now ready to begin writing "All About" books. The children will make a list of topics they know a lot about and will begin planning, writing, and revising their books this week. Please be sure to ask your child what topics

they plan on writing about. At this point in the year your child should be able to write several teaching books.

- "What do you know about your topic? (they need to know at least 5 facts)
- "What do you think they need to learn about _____?"

Having conversations with your child about their topics will really help them feel successful.
