Color Coding with Paint - Highlight an area and give a highlight color. Click the Paint Roller tool and highlight another area or click on a word to highlight again.

Color code using varies color: Yellow for spelling, blue for punctuation.

Automatic Substitution -

Create a bank of short words to represent a whole comment.

Use Suggestion Mode while working!

To set up, open a Google Doc, Click Tools, Click Preferences, Type in Abbreviation followed by Explanation.

List of Examples to Use

gd =Good answer - I like your thinking here.

howshow = how does it show this? be specific!

punc = punctuation is a requirement to a complete sentence

cap = capitalization is required for a complete sentence.

directions = you didn't follow the directions here.

mc = missing citation

comp = This isn't a complete sentence.

Create a Bank of Comments to use while working with students on Google Classroom Documents.

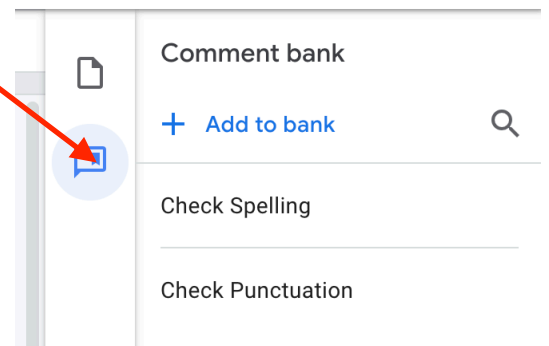
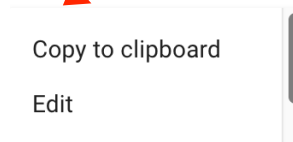
To setup Comment Bank: Click the Comment Bank Icon while once you are on a student's document.

Click to Add to Bank - Type your words for the bank.

To Use: Highlight an area on the document, click the Comment Icon

In the Comment Bank, hover on the comment you want to use, Click the 3 vertical dots and select "Copy to Clipboard"

Click in the Comment box and Paste.
