Adding a movie directly to Google Classroom can be a slow process. If you attach a video to Google Classroom the program will reroute the video to your Google Drive for storage. This is a slow process, often causing errors.

This help document guides you through the process of uploading to your Google Drive first, followed by linking the video to Google Classroom.



First Create a New Folder in Google Drive to store the videos.

3. Name the Folder - click Create



4. Double Click to open the folder.





8. The movie will upload and display the progress. Large movies will be slow to uploade.
