1. Make a timeline about your life. Include at least seven important events that have happened thus far. Add at least three pictures that go with your events.

3. Write a speech convincing your parents to make you president of the family. Explain all of the reasons you would make a good president. What qualities do you have that make you a better president? I.e. Are you dependable? Explain why. Who would you pick as vice president and why? Finally, make a campaign poster!
4. Draw a comic strip about a time period that you know about in history. Make sure you have at least five frames.
5. Think about something that we use today, everyday. Choose one specific item and write a paragraph (5-8 sentences) about what you think life was like without this item i.e. How would life be more challenging, what do you think they did/used instead?

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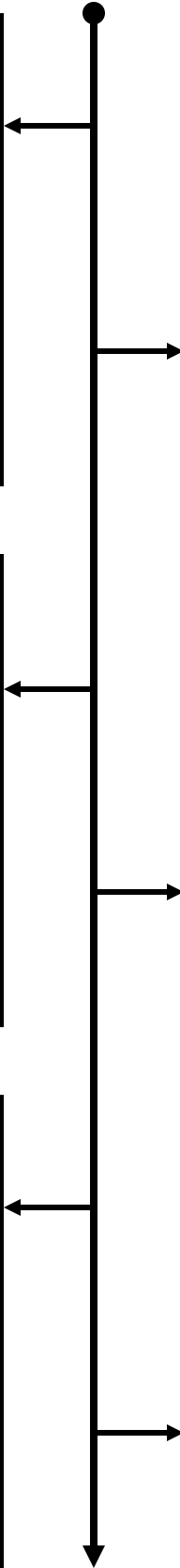
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
