How are they alike and different?


Create <u>2 new</u> solutions for the story.

Choose at least 3 spelling activities to complete this week. The activities must make a tic-tac-toe line: horizontal, vertical, or diagonal three-in-a-row. Have a grown-up initial next to the activities you complete. You may substitute these activities with your own if you wish.

Have a parent scramble your spelling words. You unscramble them. (tac = cat)	Get a timer. Set it for 3 minutes. See how many times you can write your words before the timer goes off.	Write each of your words 3 times to make a triangle.
