This part of the lesson is about creating vehicles and robots.


There are examples where you can just cut out and put together your project.
There are also blank outlines and you can color them any way you'd like.







- Draw and color the blanks if you don't want to use the examples

- Your creation done and you can enjoy making up stories about them.


























## **Robot Blocks**

Assemble the cube.







