- Science Update
 - *Night & Day Homework On Monday in your child's folder, there will be a nightly task to observe and record patterns in the sky at various times during the evening 6, 6:30, 7 PM (times may be adjusted if needed). Students should keep the observation log in their Come & Go folder and bring in to school daily so that we may discuss each morning. Children who fill out 4 out of 5 days each week will receive a homework incentive
 - Our winter spring seed planting starts the day after the first day of spring! We will germinate salad
 green seeds and begin asking questions, making predictions, and observing the process of sprouting
 seeds, allowing for harvest in about a week or two. Tools and materials have been provided by a grant.
 - Night & Day Study Groups begins this week and next (observe predictable cycles of the earth and understand that earth's movement affects night and day)
