Last Week, This Week (and Next Week) We're Working on...

- Reading: Author intentionality powerful parts of a book & how they're powerful, lessons from books Word Detectives using specific word solving strategies to solve bigger words this can be done with 3 and 4 letter words or complex 3 or 4 syllable words
 - I have been and will continue to give stronger readers opportunities to write about their reading through written responses of problem identification and resolution, reflection on the author's purpose
 - Developing readers have been working on building their good fit book inventory and reading for longer stretches of time while also using post it notes to highlight favorite or interesting parts.
 - I've been encouraging a wider variety of book choice in book bags some children get comfortable with a
 particular series or genre (which is great for developing readers), but once we become more voracious readers,
 wide variety book choice becomes a little more important
- Social Studies/Study Groups: This week we start over with a brand new study group. If your child had me for community, they'll move on this week to World Cultures with Ms. Lowe. Ms. Lowe's Culture group will move on to Mrs. Stinson's Maps & Globes. Maps and Globes study group will shift to Mrs. Erb's Wabanaki study group and Wabanaki study group from last round will shift to community in my room
- Word Work/Handwriting:
 - Handwriting Con't to form lowercase letters "magic c" letters a, d, g & then on to remaining vowels u, e, i
 - Making words First graders word families of et, -ot, op, or ep in them, blends with st, and –ed inflected ending
 -Second graders St Blends, vowel teams with ea, oa, oe, plurals with es
- Writing: We have started working on revision in our writing. We've assigned 1st & 2nd & 3rd grade writing checklists. Over the coming weeks, we'll continue to order our pages into the books, find ways to edit, rewrite and revise our small moment books ultimately designing a title and dedication page in the computer lab and ready them for publishing by conference time

o **1**st **Grade Math**: Addition to 10 for another week. We've started our fact fluency (practicing addition for numbers to 10)

- This week we've read a few books on mindfulness *What Does it Mean to Be Present* & *Be Where Your Feet Are.* This week we'll look to build our mindfulness in helping others and working together.
