Last Week, This Week (and Next Week) We're Working on...

- Reading: Word Solving Strategies (1st and 2nd grade skills), Paying Attention to Author's Purpose
- Social Studies/Study Groups –Ox Cart Man Study Groups
 - This week we visit Ms. Lowe's room Comparing Ox *Cart Man* products now and long ago, plus a science/Art exploration of potatoes, turnips and apples three food products from the book
 - Next week's study group will be in Mrs. Stinson's room Seasons and comparing the seasonal cycle in *Ox Cart Man* to various repeat cycles of our lives school, special holidays, anything that repeats and restarts year after year

Woods Walk/Outdoor Explore

- Last week, we gathered nature items to to create a "Leaf Man" based on the book of the same title. We also noticed that the wind can move leaves and seed
- Next week: Seed collection and comparison predicting where we might find seeds, making scientific claims on what the seeds might be, drawing seeds like a scientist and comparing other peers' seeds

Word Work/Handwriting/Spelling

- Handwriting We have finished reviewing capital letters and will move on to formation of lowercase letters small, tall, and descending letters, practicing sitting them on lines proportionately (weeks long process)
- Making Words 1st gr. world families (ig, up, in, eg, ug, plural adding -s), 2nd gr. (r-controlled vowels or, diphthongs ng, inflected endings -ing, contractions)
- 1st Grade Math: Chapter 3 Addition to 10 Making addition sentences, strategies to add, real world stories
- 2nd Grade Math: Continuing Chapter 2 + & to 1,000 adding and subtracting with and without regrouping
