- Making Words Gr. 1 (word families as, at, cvce long a, sk, sc -es endings r-controlled vowel er, cvce long a, sc, -es), Gr. 2 (long vowels patterns ea, ai, cvce i, homophones)
- **Continued Differentiated Word Sort Practice** word work ranging from short vowels and blends to long vowel patterns & r-controlled vowels (and everything in between)

**1st Grade Math**: **Chapter 5** - Shapes - Plane and solid shapes, finding shapes in the world around us, shape patterns **2nd Grade Math**: **Chapter 6** - Multiplication (2's, 5's, 10's)
