RE: **Notice of 6-Month Surveillance for Asbestos**

PLEASE POST THIS NOTICE IN ALL SCHOOLS

On February 23, 2012, all Brunswick Schools have received the 6-month surveillance for the presence of asbestos containing materials in compliance with the EPA Asbestos Hazard Emergency Response Act (AHERA). Written management plans are available for public inspection. Copies of the plans are located at the school administrative office or in each individual building and can be viewed during normal business hours.

The EPA requires re-inspections of the asbestos materials every three years and a survey every six months. An accredited management planner reviewed the results of the surveys and recommended, if any, actions that should be taken to safely manage asbestos in the buildings.
