Dear Parents of HBS:

Foreign Language for Youth (FLY) – a group of parents and other volunteers who bring foreign language experiences to the children of Brunswick’s elementary schools – is anticipating the start of its 21<sup>th</sup> year in 2019.

- FLY’s primary goal is to offer each elementary student in Brunswick the opportunity to explore at least one world language. Languages that have been offered in the past include French, German, Italian, Japanese, Korean, Mandarin Chinese, Spanish, and Swedish.
- The program begins in January with each of the language classes meeting once a week, after school (approximately from 3:15-4:15), for 10 to 12 weeks.

This year’s program cannot “take off” without the support of new volunteers! We are in need of help in the following areas:

- **Teachers/Assistant Teachers:** responsible for attending one informational meeting in early December and preparing and teaching or helping in one of the classes. No previous experience is necessary. You just need to know the basics of a foreign language and like working with young learners to teach these classes. *As a volunteer, you will need to complete a Brunswick School Department volunteer form, agree to a background check and attend an orientation meeting.*
