TO DO CHECKLIST

Water:

- Water if it's been a couple of days since the last rainy day, if the soil feels dry, or if the plants look wilted.
- Do not water on a sunny day between 11 am and 3 pm. If the sun is still strong, use the watering cans and try not to wet the leaves of the plants.
- The water hook up for the front garden is on the Gym wall, above the hosta plants. There is another water tap between on the brick boiler building across from the school's main entrance, between the two handicap parking spots on the wall of the heating. The hook up for the back garden is between the mobile and the building. It is on the building near the door by the chorus room. The key (Allen wrench) to turn the water on and off is attached to the shelf to the right in the shed. When done watering, make sure you have fully closed the spigot and it is not dripping.
- There is a water sprinkler and the instructions for it are in a box on the shelf in the shed.

Weed:

Please weed around plants and put pulled weeds in the compost bins.

Pests:

- A list of the most common pests and one of the beneficial insects are hanging the shelf, together with the garden plan.
- One of the most effective organic methods is hand picking. Fill a container halfway with soapy water and throw the buggers in. Containers with lids and soap are in the shed.
