Estimated time home is 11:00 PM. Note: students will need lunch & dinner on this trip. They can bring their own lunch and/or dinner or money to buy one or both. We will be eating lunch on campus at the Memorial Union Food Court and dinner at the mall. There are a wide variety of choices and price points at both meal locations.

I would encourage parents to come down for the day or at least to hear our performance. Tickets for the day are \$2. That gets you into any/all daytime performances and clinics! Please note: Tickets are required for the evening concert and are usually "sold out" by the registration deadline. I have already ordered enough tickets for our group including chaperones.
