The Wind Ensemble and Advanced Choir will be participating in the Great East Festival in Amesbury, MA on Friday, May 24. This is an adjudicated performance. We will play for 2 judges who will evaluate our performance. We'll receive a score sheet and recorded comments from each judge. One of the judges will do a short clinic with the group at the end of the performance.

We will be leaving BJH at 7:00 AM. The Wind Ensemble is tentatively scheduled to perform at 10:30. (Advanced Choir is scheduled for 10:00.) Our performance will be in the Amesbury Middle School Auditorium (220 Main St., Amesbury, MA). The performances are open to the public.

Following our performances, we will spend the rest of the afternoon at Canobie Lake Park in New Hampshire. Unless weather conditions cause our plans to change, we will head for home around 5:00. We should be back at school around 7:30 PM.

Brunswick School Department covers MOST of the costs for this festival including the group registration fee, and a portion of the student fee. The remaining cost for each student will be \$25. (Note: this does not include "spending money" for the amusement park (money for food, souvenirs, etc...). If your child is in both Wind Ensemble and Advanced Choir, they only need to pay ONE \$25 student fee! If you need financial assistance to cover the cost of the trip, please let me know as soon as possible. There is scholarship money available.

Dress for the festival is "all black" (long shorts/capris would be appropriate). We are not allowed to change clothes at the performance site and students will not be allowed to change on the bus! Students may change in the bathrooms at the park but they will not be able to go back to the bus to leave clothes/bags. There are lockers available for rental.

From the Canobie Lake Park website:

Q: Do you rent lockers at the Park?

A: Yes we do. All day locker rentals are available at the rental counter located across from the entrance to the Giant Sky Wheel. We have three sizes available: the small locker costs \$5, a medium costs \$7 and a large costs \$10. A \$5 refundable key deposit is required in addition to the locker fee. *Prices subject to change without notice.

Plan accordingly! Regardless of whether you stay in concert clothes or plan on changing, clothing MUST MEET BJH DRESS CODE!

This trip will involve two meals (lunch and dinner). FYI- Canobie does not allow food and/or beverage to be brought into the park but there are LOTS of food choices in a wide range of prices. Students can also bring a small cooler or bag lunch to eat on the bus on the way to the park and/or on the way home. I can also arrange for a "field trip bag lunch" from school. Please let me know as soon as possible if you would like this option.
