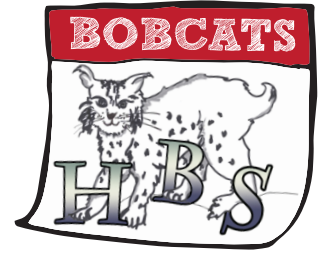


# SCG Newsletter
