



We have had a great October here in room 2. This month we have spent some time fine tuning our school and classroom rules and routines. Our classroom community is still developing! We are working very hard as a whole class on following directions.

We have been learning about apples and pumpkins this month. We also started our self-unit for science and learned the five senses. Ask your child what they are! We are focusing on uppercase letters right know. We also launched our Writers Workshop and are learning that we are all writers!

In math, we have learned about the numbers 6-10 in chapter 2. We have continued to learn about the calendar, recording the weather, and we counted the number of days we have been here at school; we are 36 days smarter!!
