We have had a busy September here in room 2. This month we have spent a lot of time learning our school and classroom rules and routines. Our classroom community is coming along very nicely and in October we will still be working to build a strong community together. I would like to thank you all for your support of the slow start we had for the transition into kindergarten. I know it is not easy around your work schedules and childcare, but it meant so much to have your patience and flexibility with that first week. It has made a huge difference for your children and I can see the success of this in our classroom!

We have been learning about our names and practicing our letters. We have read many books about kindergarten and school. We have been reading chants and poems together as a class as well. I know many of you saw our first two poems in our poetry notebooks during open house! There will be many more to be added throughout the year.

In math, we have learned about the numbers 1-5 in chapter 1. We have learned about the calendar, recording the weather and we have counted the number of days we have been here at school. So far, we have been in Kindergarten for 18 days! Ask your child if they can remember the "Days of the Week" song!
