Inherited Traits: Organizing Information

Purpose: To investigate the inherited traits of students in the classroom, organize the information in a chart, and present the information as a set of bar graphs.

- 2. Ask each student these questions--
 - A. Can you curl the sides of your tongue upward in a tongue roll?
 - B. Do you have attached or unattached earlobes?
 - C. What color are your eyes?
