Writing Haiku

- Haiku is a traditional form of Japanese poetry.
- Haiku poems consist of 3 short lines.
- The first and last lines of a Haiku have 5 syllables.
- The middle line has 7 syllables.
- Leave out all unnecessary words.
- No metaphors.
- The lines rarely rhyme.
- Do NOT start a sentence with “The.”
- The first and middle line should be different images.
- The last line ties the first two lines together and makes the first two lines make sense.

An Example of Haiku:

*Looking for the moon.
In a lonely autumn sky.
Mountain castle lights.*

Note the syllables of Haiku:

*Look/ing for the moon. (5 syllables)
In a lone/ly au/tumn sky. (7 syllables)
Mount/ain cas/tle lights. (5 syllables)*
