Many questions will need to be answered on how we will work at school and home, so here is a start to a few.


- > 2 days when at school you will learn, discuss, try-out things, and share. Schedule is on page 4.

- > On remote (at-home) days you will have the flexibility to schedule the completion of your assignments from the "My Work from Ms. Thayer" sheet.
- > No virtual meets required when your Cohort is not at school.
- > Folders that you will use at school, bring home and then return to school will be clipped together and color coded. All these folders are waiting for you in your Blue Workboxes at school.
- > Our Classroom Website will be our Community Newsletter Bulletin for Families. *Updates are starting this week.*
- > Google Classroom will be the online learning, assignment and messaging platform for students. Invites to join your 5th Grade Google Classroom will be one of next week's assignments. *Stay Tuned!*
- > All 5th Graders will be given school gmail accounts for their teachers to communicate directly with students. *Stay Tuned!*
- Google Meet will be our primary way of Meeting Virtually and will be accessed through our Google Classroom. As opportunities become available for connecting virtually, I will inform and invite you to participate. Stay tuned!

All these things and more will be introduced, explained and rolled out in the coming weeks ahead. Be patient and we will work towards progress, not perfection in learning our community routines for at-school and home.




