## Ms. Groves Proficiency Assessment Retake Policy

## 1. What are Graduation Standards?

- Algebra classes have 3 Power Standards that are to meet graduations requirements:

O Numbers and Quantity (NAQ),
o Algebra (ALG), and
o Functions (FUNC).

- Each of these graduation standards are broken down into Performance Indicators are called PI's. The rubrics for the PI's are on my website:

## 2. How are Standards Assessed?

- Standard Assessments will be abbreviated S.A.
- PI’s will be assessed over the course of the year. Once a PI is assessed it will be given a score -
o Does Not Meet (DNM),
o Partially Meets (PM),
o Meets (M), or
0 Exceeds (E).
- Students MUST "Meet" or "Exceed" each PI.
- For each PI, a student scores a "Partially Meets" or "Does Not Meet," they will need to Retake the assessment.
- Students will be limited to 2 Retake opportunities to meet the standard for full credit (students must complete in the quarter the S.A. was given).


## 3. Student Ownership:

- Students are responsible for checking PowerSchool for your current Standards Progress.
- Students are responsible to follow the Retake Policy outlined below.
- Students are responsible for making sure they are meeting their Power Standards!!!
- To advance to Geometry next year the 3 Power Standards MUST BE MET.
- If the Student does NOT meet the 3 Power Standards, they will receive an incomplete for their Algebra 1 course until they are met.

4. Times Ms. Groves will be available for meetings and administer Retakes:

Email me 24-hours in advance for meetings so I put you on my calendar and wait for a confirmation email from me.

In your email, let me know what the purpose of the meeting will be, such as: (1) review your original S.A.; (2) answer your questions on concepts; and (3) schedule your Retake.
These are my available times:

- FLEX - limited to 2 students per FLEX
- Study Hall (5/6B) - limited to 6 students per SH
- Tuesdays, 2:10-3PM - limited to 6 students
- By Appointment - 3/4B, 5/60, MONDAY and Friday after school


## 5. Check list to prepare for Retake:

$\square$ Meet with Ms. Groves to review the assessment. Assessment will NOT be returned to the student. Students should take notes on what they did wrong to help them study for their retake.
$\square$ Complete yellow copy "Practice Assessment" located in the crate in the back of my room. Work MUST be shown clearly to demonstrate complete understanding of the concepts.
$\square$ Self-correct yellow copy "Practice Assessment" from my website:

$\square$ Hand in to your class box the self-corrected yellow copy "Practice Assessment" with work clearly to shown to demonstrate complete understanding of the concepts.
$\square$ Wait for confirmation from Ms. Groves that your yellow copy "Practice Assessment" was completed correctly to set up time to take Retake.
$\square$ (optional-email to set up time) Meet with Ms. Groves if you have any questions on concepts. Remember, students will be limited to 2 Retake opportunities. Make them count!
$\square$ Email Ms. Groves to set up a time to Retakes. See above for available times.
