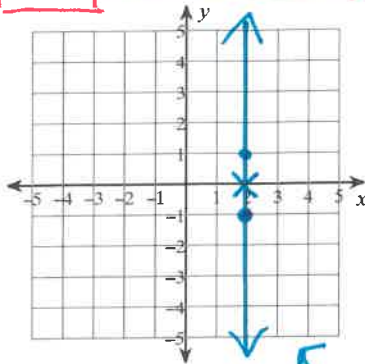

1)  $x = 2$   $\rightarrow$   $x$  is ALWAYS 2

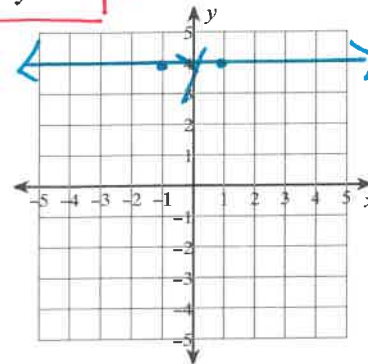


| x | y  |

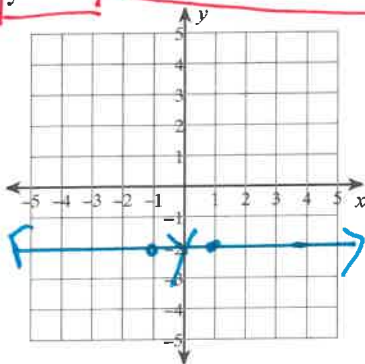
2)  $y = 4$   $\rightarrow$   $y$  is ALWAYS 4



| x  | y |
|----|---|
| -1 | 4 |
| 0  | 4 |
| 1  | 4 |

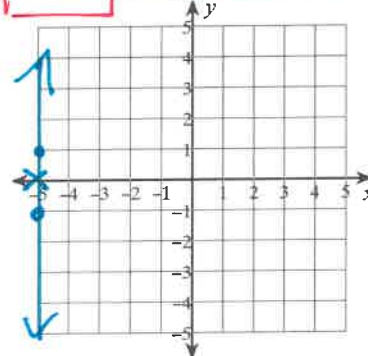
↑  
Pick -1, 0, 1 for x

3)  $y = -2$



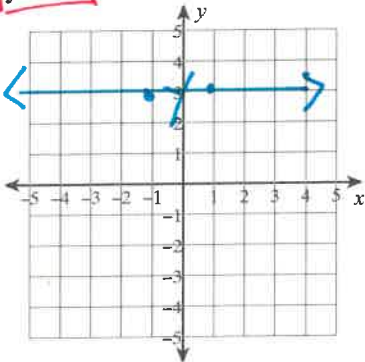
| x  | y  |
|----|----|
| -1 | -2 |
| 0  | -2 |
| 1  | -2 |

4)  $x = -5$



| x  | y  |
|----|----|
| -5 | -1 |
| -5 | 0  |
| -5 | 1  |

5)  $y = 3$



| x  | y |
|----|---|
| -1 | 3 |
| 0  | 3 |
| 1  | 3 |

- ② Make x + y intercepts on Graph with x or y.
