










### The Election of 1796





## The Election of 1796 - It's A Tie! (?)

Federalist electors voted for Adams



Republican electors voted for Jefferson

Constitution says:
President is the candidate who wins
the most electoral votes

Vice-President is candidate with the next highest number of votes

#### The XYZ Affair

President Adams sent a team to France to negotiate a treaty



3 Frenchmen demanded a \$250,000 bribe

"millions for defense, but not once cent for tribute"

everyone wanted war, but Adams knew we couldn't win smoothed things over w/the French but lost political support

#### The Alien and Sedition Acts




Federalists wanted to silence their critics, many of whom were foreign-born who wanted the US to go to war w/France (ship seizures)

The Alien Acts
President can deport any alien
during peace

The Sedition Acts made sedition illegal

raised residency requirement for citizenship from 5-14 yrs.

# The Virginia and Kentucky Resolutions



Jefferson and Madison organized support in the southern Republican states against these acts

VA and KY declared that states had the right to declare a federal law unconstitutional within their borders and not follow it
