- e. Budget Update - Mr. Oikle

Mr. Oikle updated the Board on the surplus and stated that the budget year for 2013 is closed out. He explained that there is an issue with \$67,000 of construction funds being disputed by the state, but that it will be resolved in the near future. He said the school department's workmen's compensation insurance company has asked for Board action to commit to promoting staff health and safety. Mrs. Connors agreed to bring the topic to the Wellness Committee. Mr. Grant said that this statement can be included in the Consent Agenda for the September Board meeting.

f. Update on Brunswick High School Principal Search

Mr. Perzanoski explained the process to search for a new principal. Search committee members include the following:
