**a.) Board Review**

1. What is the revised cost of a new school on the Jordan Acres site including the razing of Jordan Acres?
2. What is the revised cost of the repair projects for Coffin School and BJHS taking into consideration the Revolving Renovation Award?
3. Once those numbers have been received, what would be the tax impact for taxpayers and effect on the operating budget?

The committee asked administration to review the 12 unit portable unit projected for Coffin in the repair option to see if the library could be moved to it. They requested other possible options to include Pre-K and the 4 portables in the back of Coffin.

**b.) Public Meetings**

The next Facilities committee meeting will be held at town Hall at 5:30 p.m. on March 15. A Public Forum on facilities will be held on Saturday, March 19 at Town Hall from 9:30am to noon.


**c.) Referendum**
