A Title I Program

Mission:

To improve Math and Literacy skills in Title 1 students at Coffin School through academic enrichment activities for students and their families during weekends/vacations.

Objectives leading to the Goal:

- Increase student engagement and self concept as successful learners, using fun, active, learning adventures
- Increase the number and percentage of Title 1 parents who participate in one or more Family Math / Family Literacy events
- Provide Title 1 teachers and other classroom teachers at Coffin School with formative assessment data to guide and inform instructional practice during regular school time

Program Overview:

- Five 6-week sessions will be offered for up to 20 students per session. (Based on availability, students may join multiple sessions).
- “Cub Camp (Saturday Math & Literacy Camp) will be offered in five 6-week sessions to Title 1 students and their families. Transportation will be provided on Saturday mornings from 4 convenient pick-up locations, taking students to _____ (Coffin School? Seeds of Independence? Some other fun space?)

Program Staffing: 5 staff for 20 students

Hours: 9:00-12:30

Daily Schedule:

- 9:00 Arrival / Snack / Check-in
- 9:20 Math Immersion Games with 3 staff members, as 2 staff members conduct Aimsweb Reading snapshots (5 minutes X 10 students)
- 10:20 Literacy Immersion Games with 3 staff members, as 2 staff members conduct Aimsweb Math snapshots
- 11:00 Recess
- 11:20-12:00 Small group instruction (3 groups)
- 12:00-12:30 Lunch / Check Out / Dismissal

Each session will include a kick-off family pizza night, where students will go into the gym for teambuilding games and parents will receive information about Title 1, materials/ resources, information, and strategies for fostering Math and Literacy skills at home. Each session will also include a capstone family pizza night / celebration of learning, and families will receive additional resources/ supplies.
