About REAL School: At REAL School, we encourage adventure-based, experiential learning through new experiences that challenge students' in new ways. We support our students in making positive choices and taking healthy risks that encourage growth and development.

Trip Overview: REAL School staff proposes a trip to Acadia National Park, Blackwoods Campground, followed by a backpacking excursion along the Bold Coast in Cutler, ME. We will be studying Maine's native American roots as well as the history of National Parks, specifically Acadia. This trip will serve as a culminating event for seniors involved in all lessons leading to this trip. Due to the high value of this activity, it will also be used as an incentive item to encourage greater school performance. Students will be invited based on interest and recent school performance. Students will be required to attend all pre-trip meetings to complete learning activities and return trip paperwork. Since many of our students come from financially insecure homes we have generated funding from outside donors and foundations for our student activity fund. Most of our students don't the opportunity to engage in these types of opportunities outside of school, so this adventure-based excursion will help to engage them in a unique way. The academic components, in addition to physicality of the hike, will expose our students to healthy risks.
