## GATE RECEIPTS AND ADMISSIONS

No person shall be allowed to attend school events to which admission is charged without a paid admission ticket or proper identification.

- I. REGULAR ADMISSION CHARGE: A listing of athletic events and other activities to which admission is regularly charged including the charges for each event shall be prepared annually in August by the Superintendent of Schools and presented to the School Board for their approval. The approved list shall subsequently be published and made available to the public.
- II. ADMISSION CHARGES TO OTHER SCHOOL EVENTS: Admission may be charged to events not listed above at the discretion of the appropriate administrator. In no case shall admission fees be greater than the maximum charge listed in accordance with Section I of this policy.
- III. FREE ADMISSION TO SCHOOL EVENTS: Although the School Board recognizes the fact that it is an economic necessity to charge admission to certain school events, it also recognizes the fact that it is in the best interest of school programs to allow some individuals access to school events free of charge by virtue of their responsibility to attend such events or by virtue of their prior service to the schools of the community or due to the fact that they or members of their families are participating in the school event(s). In addition, it is recognized that reciprocal arrangements between schools to allow free admission for visiting staff members is also in the best interest of the various programs. Therefore, the following individuals or groups of individuals may be admitted to school events without charge subject to any conditions listed in this section which apply to them.
  - A. Staff members and their spouses associated with the specific school involved or the specific sport or activity involved.
  - B. Members of other Brunswick teams active during the same sports season.
  - C. All students under twelve (12) years of age if accompanied by a parent or a responsible person holding an adult ticket.

- D. Participants in the contest or activity may be eligible for free admission tickets to each event in which the student participates for use by a member of the participant's family.
- E. All Brunswick School Board members and Brunswick School Administrators and their spouses.
- F. Persons rendering or who have rendered special services to the schools upon recommendation of the appropriate administrator and approval of the Superintendent of Schools.
- G. Senior citizens age 65 and over.
- H. Up to 10 members of the staff of the opposing school upon presentation of proper identification.
- I. Visiting athletic scouts (limit two from each school per contest).

In all cases, proper identification shall be required for free admission to any event.

IV. All proceeds from admission charges to school events shall be deposited in the student activity account and, where applicable, forwarded to the Office of the Superintendent of Schools for transmission to the Town of Brunswick.
