## STUDENT ATTENDANCE

All students must be enrolled in a physical education program. Temporary or permanent waiver of this requirement may be granted by the Principal as follows:

## I. HANDICAPPED STUDENTS

Students with permanent handicaps which make it inappropriate for them to participate in physical education may be excused upon the written advice of the child's physician.

## II. SHORT-TERM EXCUSED PARTICIPATION

The physical education instructor may excuse participation for up to 3 consecutive classes at his/her discretion for health reasons. Requests for excused participation may be referred to the school nurse.

## III. LONG-TERM EXCUSED PARTICIPATION

- A. Long-term excuse from participation in physical education (more than 3 consecutive classes) for health reasons requires:
  - 1. A letter from the attending physician requesting such excuse;
  - 2. A statement from the attending physician indicating a projected duration for the excuse.
- B. Extensions may be granted by the Principal when he/she determines the action to be in the best interest of the child or upon request of the attending physician.
