SCHOOL SPONSORED RECORDING OF EVENTS IN BRUNSWICK SCHOOLS

The Superintendent of Schools or designee may allow recording of school sponsored events in the public schools for broadcast on local cable access channels, as appropriate. Parents will be made aware that an event may be recorded for a later broadcast on the town's cable network.

Factors to be considered by the Superintendent or designee in allowing recording shall include, but are not limited to, the nature of the event, educational value, community interest, safety and welfare of students and staff, administrative cost and convenience, and considerations of privacy/confidentiality and decorum. All such activity will honor the school department's policy on Student Education Records File: JRA, and any pertinent copyright laws.

The term, "recording", shall include photography, film, sound, and videotape recording.

The term, "events", shall include public presentations, plays, forums, musicals and other educational activities.
