Sample Lessons And Activities	<ul> <li>Discuss mood.</li> <li>Discuss how a variety of kinds of mark making and lines can create different feelings, emotions and ideas.</li> <li>In individual sketchbooks create a series of small compositions which portray a variety of feelings and emotions.</li> <li>Create a work of art that uses line quality to express a chosen emotion.</li> <li>Create a pastel drawing using mark making and color to express a mood or idea.</li> </ul>
