Essential Understandings	Financial Aid can help students finance their post-secondary education. Knowledge of the process of applying for financial aid allows students to explore opportunities and make appropriate decisions regarding their individual post-secondary goals and options.
Essential Questions	What skills are needed to investigate and evaluate financial aid options and complete necessary applications?
Essential Knowledge	Students will understand the value of post-secondary education as it relates to career and life goals, will identify cost of financing a post-secondary education and will understand the process of applying for financial aid.
Vocabulary (examples)	Financial Aid, FAFSA, CSS Profile, Pell Grant, Supplemental Grant, College Work Study, Stafford Loan, Perkins Loan, Merit Scholarship, Need Based Scholarship etc.
