On January 31, 2017, **Air Quality Management** performed an AHERA 3-Year Re-Inspection for the presence of asbestos containing materials for each school building currently involved in Brunswick's EPA Asbestos Hazard Emergency Response (AHERA). This inspection was conducted in accordance with the requirements of the EPA Asbestos Hazard Emergency Response Act (AHERA), 40 CFR Part 763. This information, with a hazard assessment developed by an accredited management planner, is included in the Asbestos Management Plan for each school.

The EPA requires re-inspections of the asbestos materials every three (3) years and a survey every six (6) months. An accredited management planner reviews the results of the surveys and recommends, if any, actions that should be taken to safely manage asbestos in your buildings.

The asbestos management plans are available for public inspection. Copies of the plans are located at the school administrative office or in each individual building and can be viewed during normal business hours.
