5. What are the benefits and resources within our community that could better support the social/emotional/academic programs in our schools?
6. What are we currently doing/not doing (in our community and/or in our schools) that could be viewed with shock and disbelief by our descendants in 100 years? (as a guide for this question, think about 100 years ago.....)
