The following questions may serve as a general guide for our conversation.

- 1. What is the general experience of minority citizens in our community?
- 2. What is the general experience of lower socioeconomic populations in our community?
- 3. What is the general experience of any/all typically "marginalized" populations in our community?
- 4. What are the (overt and invisible) barriers to equity for families and individuals in our community?
- 5. What are the benefits and resources within our community that could better support the social/emotional/academic programs in our schools?
- 6. What are we currently doing/not doing (in our community and/or in our schools) that could be viewed with shock and disbelief by our descendants in 100 years? (as a guide for this question, think about 100 years ago......)
