End of Year Academic Report for Students

Coffin Elementary School & Harriet Beecher Stowe School (PreK-5)

In the absence of extenuating circumstances that have already been discussed between teachers, administration and families, students will advance to the next grade. Instead of an end of year report card, each student will receive a narrative report from their classroom teacher.

Brunswick Junior High School

Students will receive a report card that shows a letter grade for the 1st and 2nd quarter, a Pass/Fail for the third and fourth quarter and a narrative comment.

Brunswick High School

Students will receive a report card that includes a percentage grade for the 1st, 2nd and 3rd quarter, a Pass/Fail grade for the fourth quarter and a narrative comment. GPA will not be impacted by Pass/Fail grades.

Summer Programming

Summer programming will be provided. We are currently exploring ways to offer summer programs virtually or in-person if possible (will be determined by state and CDC guidance). More information will be provided when plans are finalized.

Food Service for Students

Brunswick School Department will continue to provide meals at the designated locations until June 19. After that date, MSAD 75 and Mid-Coast Hunger Prevention will provide meals as part of the Summer Meals Program. Details are still being finalized and will be shared when they are available.
