



ESEA Grant Application Public Notice 2020-21

Every district is required under the Every Student Succeeds Act (ESEA) to post the intended use for grant funds for the public to provide comment or ask questions.

Title IA:

- Improving the Academic Achievement of the Disadvantaged

Preliminary Allocation:

- \$337,693 (**Decrease of \$31,926*)

Required District Projects Include:

- Homeless Students

Grant Projects:

- Title IA Grant funds will be used to support salaries and benefits of Title IA teachers who will provide supplemental math and literacy support for K-2 students.

Title IIA:

- Preparing, Training and Recruiting High-Quality Teachers, Principals, and Other School Leaders

Preliminary Allocation:

- \$82,883.61 (**Decrease of \$7,403.39*)

Grant Projects:

- Title IIA funds will be used to support professional development, including: tuition reimbursement costs, purchased services for professional development of teachers, principals, and other school leaders to improve content knowledge and classroom practice.
- Title IIA funds will be used to support recruitment and retention activities that will focus on mentoring and induction programming.
- Title IIA funds will be used to provide teachers with materials, supplies, and equipment, which will be used strictly for professional development.

Title IV:

- Student Support & Academic Enrichment

Preliminary Allocation:

- \$38,567.34 (*Increase of \$2,576.34*)

Grant Projects:

- Title IV funds will be used to support well-rounded programming including: educational opportunities that integrate multiple disciplines and strengthen instruction.
- Title IV funds will be used to support safe and healthy programming including: bullying prevention, relationship building skills, dropout prevention, school-based health and mental health, trauma-informed classroom management and school wide positive behavioral interventions and supports.
